

Privacy Notice: Registration for BPhO Competition

In the course of completing this registration form, you have provided information about yourself and if you are a teacher, your students ('personal data'). We (the British Physics Olympiad and The University of Oxford) are the joint 'data controllers' for this information, which means we decide how to use it and are responsible for looking after it in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation and associated data protection legislation. The University of Oxford and BPhO have a data sharing agreement in place.

How we use your data

We will use your data to process your application for the BPhO Competition. Using your data in this way is necessary for a task that we carry out to meet our legitimate interests in supporting physics education and promoting applications to Higher Education.

We may also ask you to provide us with information about your students, including their names, BPhO exam scripts or BPhO examination marks. This data will be deleted within one year of the event.

We may also ask you to provide us with sensitive information (special category data) about yourself and your students, including accessibility requirements. This information will only be used to ensure accessibility to the papers will be deleted within 3 weeks of the event.

We will only use data for the purposes for which we collected it, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another related reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose. If we need to use your data for an unrelated purpose, we will seek your consent to use it for that new purpose. Please note the information will not be used by the University for Admissions purposes.

Sharing your data with third parties

Student names will be provided to Lavenham Press, as a third party, who provide a service on our behalf. Lavenham Press will process your data by printing student names and sending out certificates for the Year 10 competition. We have a contractual arrangement with Lavenham Press and require them to take appropriate security measures to protect your data in line with our policies. We do not allow them to use your data for their own purposes. We permit them to process your data only for specified purposes and in accordance with our instructions.

Who has access to your data?

Access to your data will be provided to those who need to view it with the British Physics Olympiad and University of Oxford as part of their work in carrying out the purposes described above.
